Resolution

1. Environmental Protection and Environmental Foresight

BE IT RESOLVED: that

- a.) IFHE should fully support the efforts of International Organisations concerning questions of environment and household behaviour,
- b.) Home Economics in all countries, endeavor to participate at all levels (political social, economic) in policy making and become actively involved in issues that related to environmental protection and environmental foresight,
- c.) Home Economics leaders should integrate environmental education as an important part of the whole education process, at every possible opportunity.

2. Health for All: Individual, Family and Society

BE IT RESOLVED: that

- a.) IFHE urge the governments of all nations to be concerned with strategies to improve Health in societies,
- b.) IFHE strongly urge governments, the UN, UNESCO, UNICEF, FAO, NGO, multilateral and bilateral organisations, voluntary organisations, financial agencies, health workers and educators to support national and international efforts to improve and promote physical and mental Health and to allocate resources to that end,
- c.) IFHE Members, through the Federation network support efforts to urge all governments to provide substantial resources for Home Economics to reach families with preventive Health programmes,
- d.) IFHE advocate co-operation amongst nations in establishing and maintaining preventive Health measures.
