### Resolution

#### **Living Conditions; a Global Responsibility, The Role of Home Economics**

**BE IT RESOLVED:** that the International Federation for Home Economics promote and support actions undertaken by Home Economists will improve living conditions, gender equality and the quality of life for families and households through:

- a.) Establish and ensuring that the volume and the value of unpaid work of women and men, households and families, is added as satellite estimates to the national accounting,
- b.) The establishment of educational programmes for all family members to enable them to identify their individual and collective needs and to satisfy them in the context of ecological and social responsibility respecting present and future generations,
- c.) Strategies that promote the public awareness and recognition regarding the complex tasks associated with family care and that increase the sharing of these activities by both male and female family members.
