- Sustainable food systems, such as farm to table

- Avoidance of food waste on all levels of food production and consumption
- Consumer consumption behavior in housing, appliances and food systems

Other subjects contributing to research and best practices related to housing, appliances and food systems are welcome. Changes in technology and sustainability impact have different impacts on housing, appliances and food systems around the world. The symposium provides opportunities for researchers to share insights from their work, exchange information and increase collaboration.
